CITY BUILDING PERMITS



Building or zoning permits are required for ALL projects including sheds, decks, signs, cement work, etc. Please make sure that you submit your building permit/zoning application in enough time for it to

be processed by Avon City Hall. The Zoning Administrator and the Building Inspector both need to review the application and sign off on all projects.

There are NO over the counter (same day) permits.

Please plan accordingly as to when you will be starting your project. Thank you.

REMINDER:

Clear your sidewalks and hydrants

It is the responsibility of property owners to clear the sidewalks adjacent to their property. Keep sidewalks and hydrants clear for emergency personnel and others!

No parking on streets if there is 2"or more of snow.

PROHIBITED:

- 1) All snow and ice not removed from public sidewalks 12 hours after the snow or other precipitation causing the condition has ceased to fall;
- 2) Placing snow on a public street after the snowplow has cleared the street.

FROZEN SERVICE LINE PREVENTION

If you have had a frozen water line in the past, the best prevention is to let a small stream of water run. Test the cold water temperature by letting the water run until it is cold then check the temperature. A tap closest to where the water enters your house is best. The temperature should be around 45 degrees. If it drops below 40 degrees, there may be an impending freeze. The cost associated with running water will remain significantly cheaper than the cost associated with thawing the service lines.

<u>DISCLAIMER</u>: It is the homeowner's responsibility to decide if it's necessary to run their tap water and to determine the duration of time needed. Contact or stop in to City Hall about a discount for residents who need to run water to prevent freezing.
