CAUTION:

In spite of the city's efforts to educate folks on reducing chlorides in our water, chloride levels in Avon have not budged. If this trend continues, the MN Pollution Control Agency has suggested requiring the city to build a lime softening plant which would likely result in an assessment to your property taxes. Our staff has been in homes recently where water softeners were set to 40 grains or more of hardness! The hardness in our water is 18 grains – set your softeners accordingly to bring our chloride levels down! Local water softening contractors (such as Erkens or Finken) are available to help you optimize your softener and offer solutions for efficiency.
