BOULEVARD/EASEMENT/RIGHT OF WAY REGULATIONS

A few reminders about the use of public property like boulevards, easements, or road right of way as we have gotten a number of complaints this summer particularly about signs and other obstructions being placed in boulevards or public right of way. Although adjacent property owners are required to maintain them, these areas are public property, governed by city ordinances which dictate the following and can be found online at www.cityofavonmn.com: It is unlawful to place anything that interferes with, obstructs the ordinary use of, or renders dangerous for passage, any public highway or right-of-way used by the public. Private signs are prohibited within the public right-of-way of any street or easement.
